##### **Day 1**

**Meeting with MAOPO (Plastic weaving):** exchange with Mrs Mimosette about plastic weaving and another waste recycling for art purpose; the interest of the W2W project and the out puts of the MSEs OCN training for her business.

**Visit to Nylon Dla 3 (RAQNY):** exchange with the representative of RAQNY, about the out puts of the civic education training; the interactions with local authorities from urban council and their sanitations activities. RAQNY have been trained by the W2W project in civic education have been supported after the training (Purchase of material for cleaning up activities, develop sensitisation tools and participation in the awareness campaign).

**Visit to ETS DJIMELI (PET collection and grinding):** exchange with some staff member of this MSEs about their market and the business. They collect plastic bottles in the town and after grinding they sell them abroad. They have a new grinding machine, made by craftsmen. Mrs Djimeli, the owner of this MSEs have rent a new site because she need more space for her to stock these plastic bottle and others waste.

**Visit to ADEC (Organic waste management):** exchange with Mr Charles the manager of ADEC about his activities and the link with the W2W project; their interactions with the households in waste collection and how the organic waste are valorize into compost organic fertilizer
